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DIGITAL PEDAGOGY DEFINED

Definition and explanation

Digital pedagogy is the study and use of contemporary digital technologies in education. The focus of digital pedagogy is on how to thoughtfully integrate digital resources and learning experience and evaluate how technology and gaming could provide methods for youth learning.

The concept of digital pedagogy stems from the ideas and practices of distance learning, but it's not only about using digital tools and technology but rather approaching them from a critical perspective. Digital pedagogy values digital content and space as an addition to traditional books or the classrooms. Educators can use new technologies to support students' digital literacy and to facilitate project task completion.

Education systems are struggling to keep up with the changes associated with technological progress. At the same time, young people spend hours using their smartphones for communication with peers, playing games, searching for information. They can send text messages and videos, publish them on Instagram and Snapchat, but they don't know how to work as a group or how to critically evaluate the knowledge found on the internet. Digital pedagogy is about digital tools and technics to apply them. It is also about considering the impact of digitalization on the effectiveness of learning.



DIGITAL PEDAGOGY METHODS

The growth of digital industries has a strong impact on the labor market and the type of skills needed in the economy and society. Many competencies frameworks specify skills for the 21st century: innovation, critical thinking, collaboration, responsibility, co-creation, and ICT skills. We strongly believe, that encouraging the use of adequate digital tools will help young people discover their passions, set and achieve entrepreneurial goals.

Methods and approaches in digital pedagogy focus on:

- open education,
- including and sharing open educational resources,

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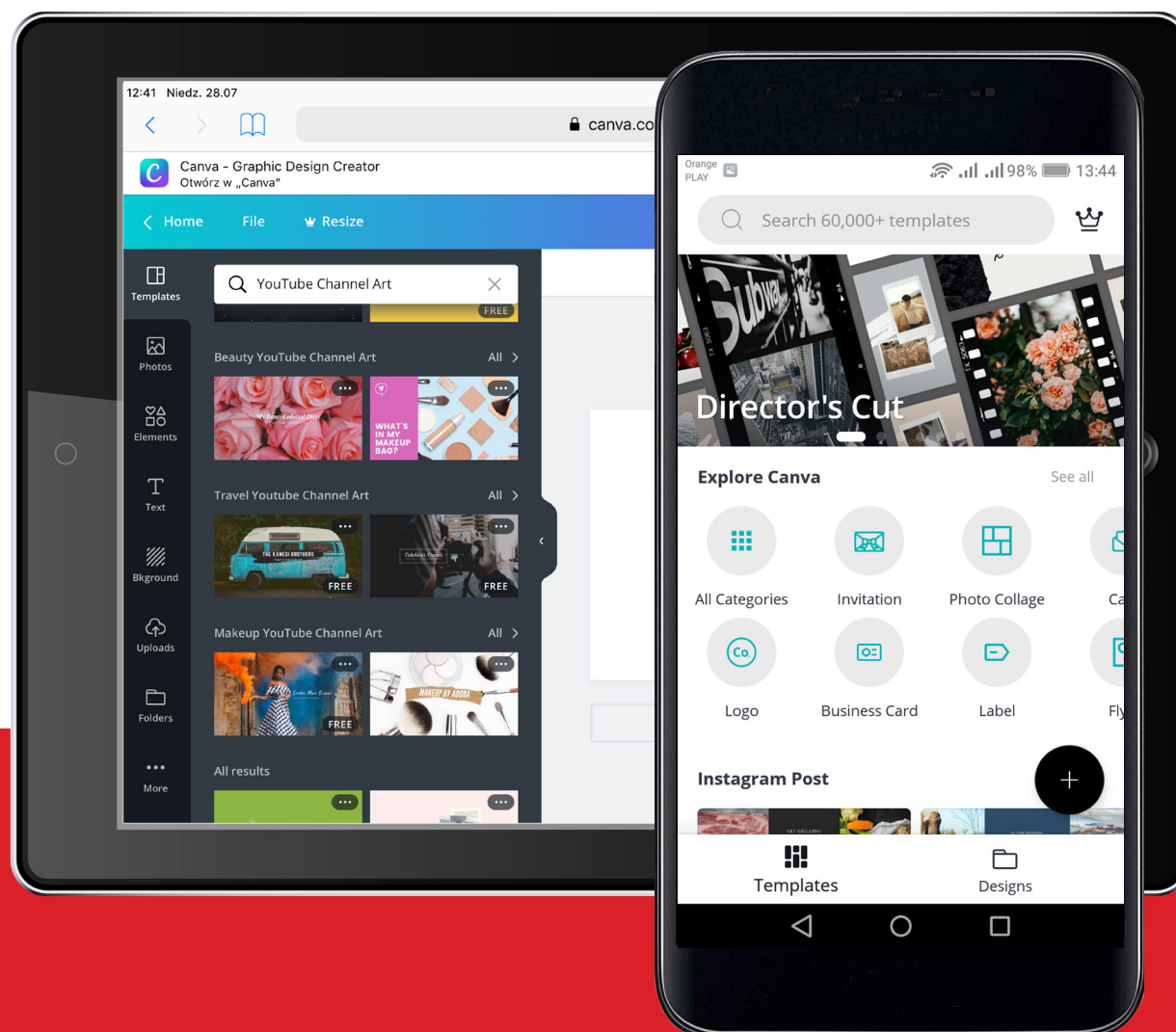

Canva is a simple design platform that provides users with a simple new way of creating beautiful headers, banners, posters for social media or personal use, regardless of your graphic design skills. Canva enables you to turn your visual concepts into professional products without having to know layout basics. Canva is great for creating content to promote your ideas and educational values.

Canva helps to create professional-looking newsletters, design elements like posters, flyers, brochures, business cards, social media content with pre-designed templates. You can sign up and use fonts, graphs, shapes and more. Search for images, photos, and create a design using Canva's drag and drop tool.

EASE OF ACCESS

Using Canva is free. You can choose professionally designed templates and change whatever you like. There are paid elements usually USD 1 each. Many features are for free, but for more you need to upgrade to the premium version. A subscription service Canva For Work enables you to access more templates, create folders to better organize your designs.

PEDAGOGICAL ASSESSMENT

Working with Canva is an easy way to get students creating digitally, although an internet connection in the classroom is needed. Canva launched a mobile app and unveiled its education services (which includes sign-in with Google Apps for Education). The company has reached out to educators for ideas and suggestions. They have a board of Education Advisors, keeping in regular contact with teachers to find ways they can improve their product.

The best way to get started with Canva as a teacher is to open a free account and start using it yourself. Make blog graphics, picture collages, quote posters for your classroom. 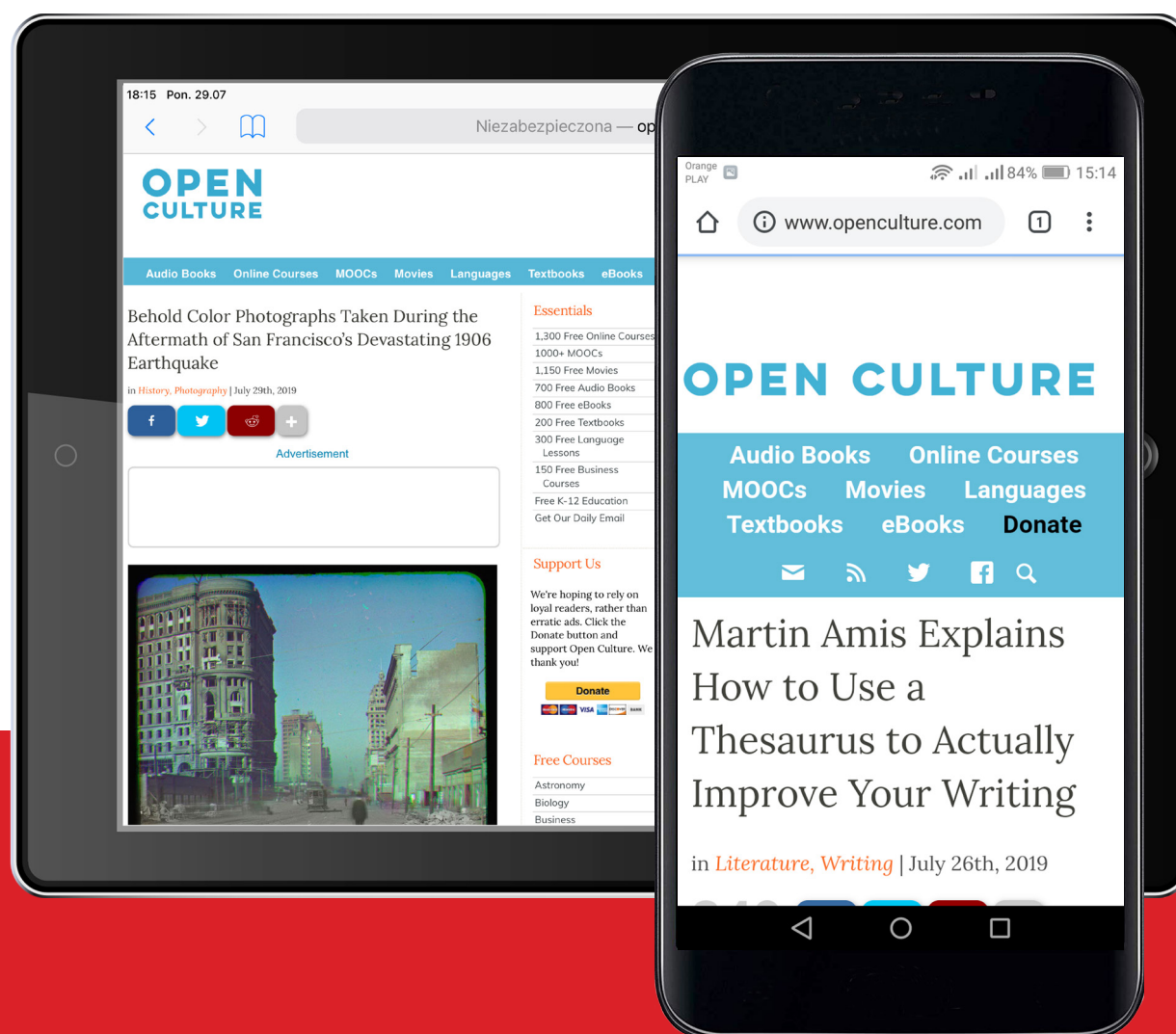

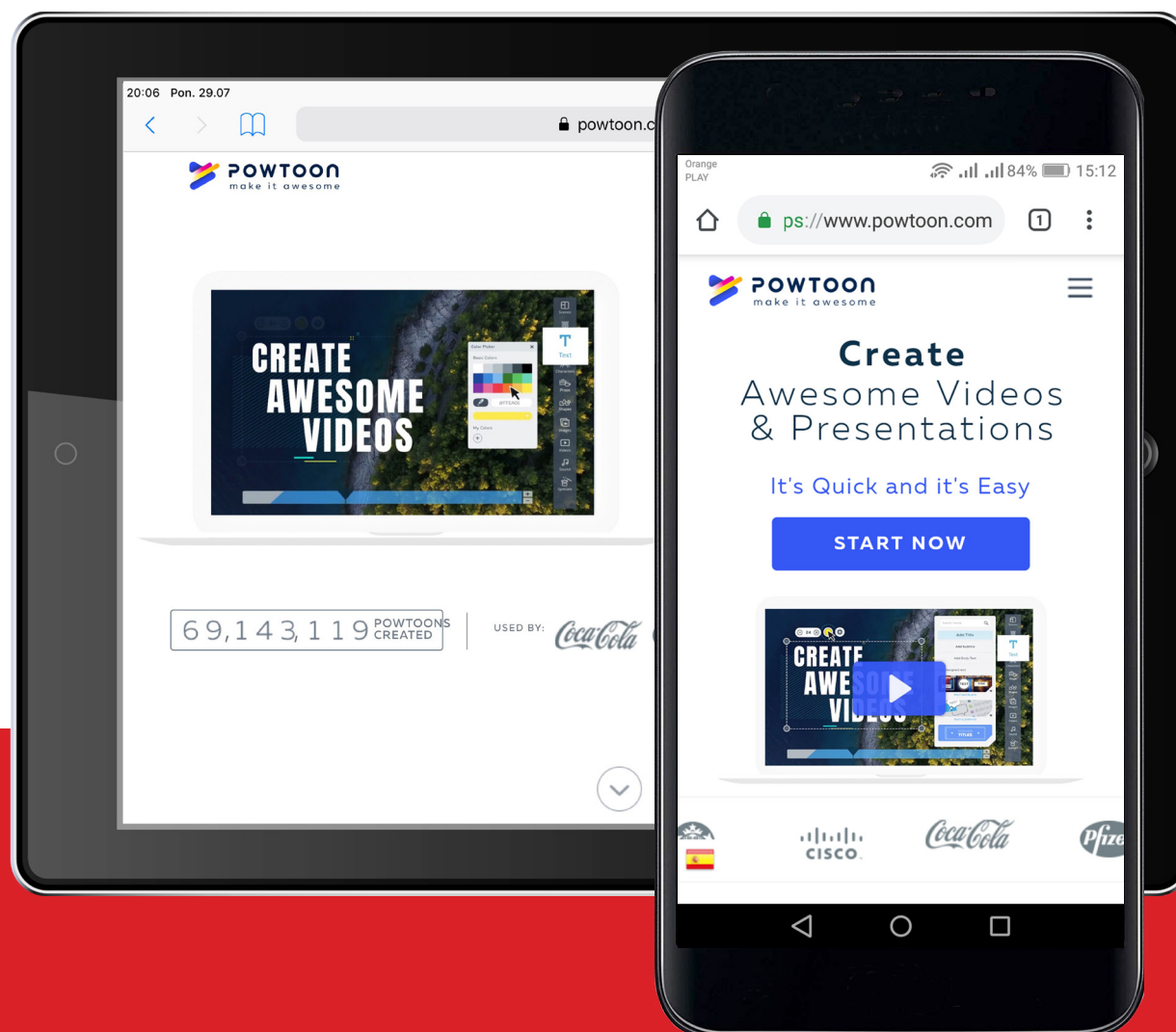

Easy to use, Powtoon generates files that can be played in the online viewer, exported to YouTube or downloaded as an MP4 file.

EASE OF ACCESS

Powtoon has a clean and intuitive interface. The program offers a huge library of professionally-designed templates, characters, props, scenes, millions of videos, soundtracks characters. The basic features are free. As it is web-based, you can access your projects from any computer with an Internet connection. Powtoon has a big community providing support and plenty of resources. 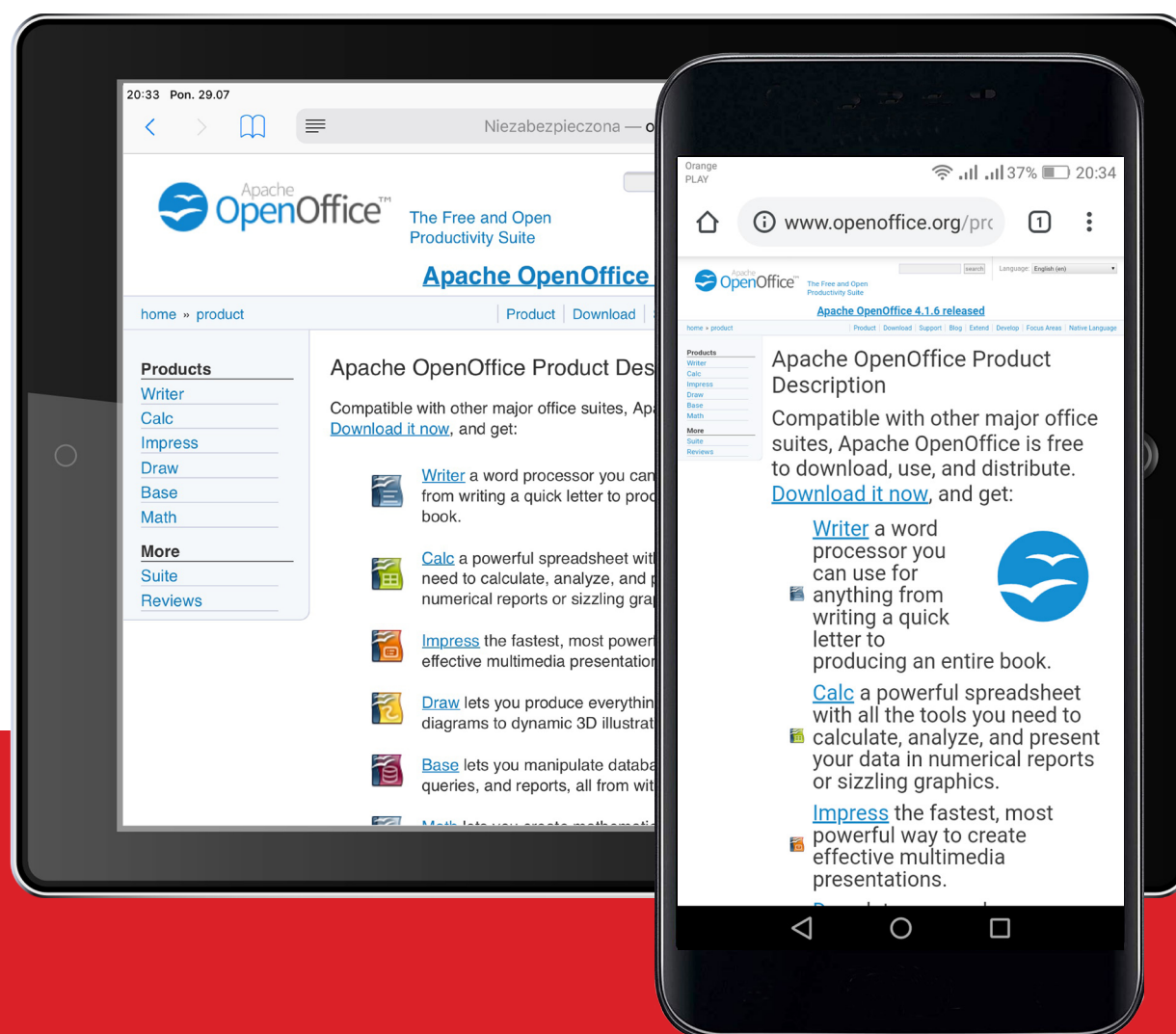

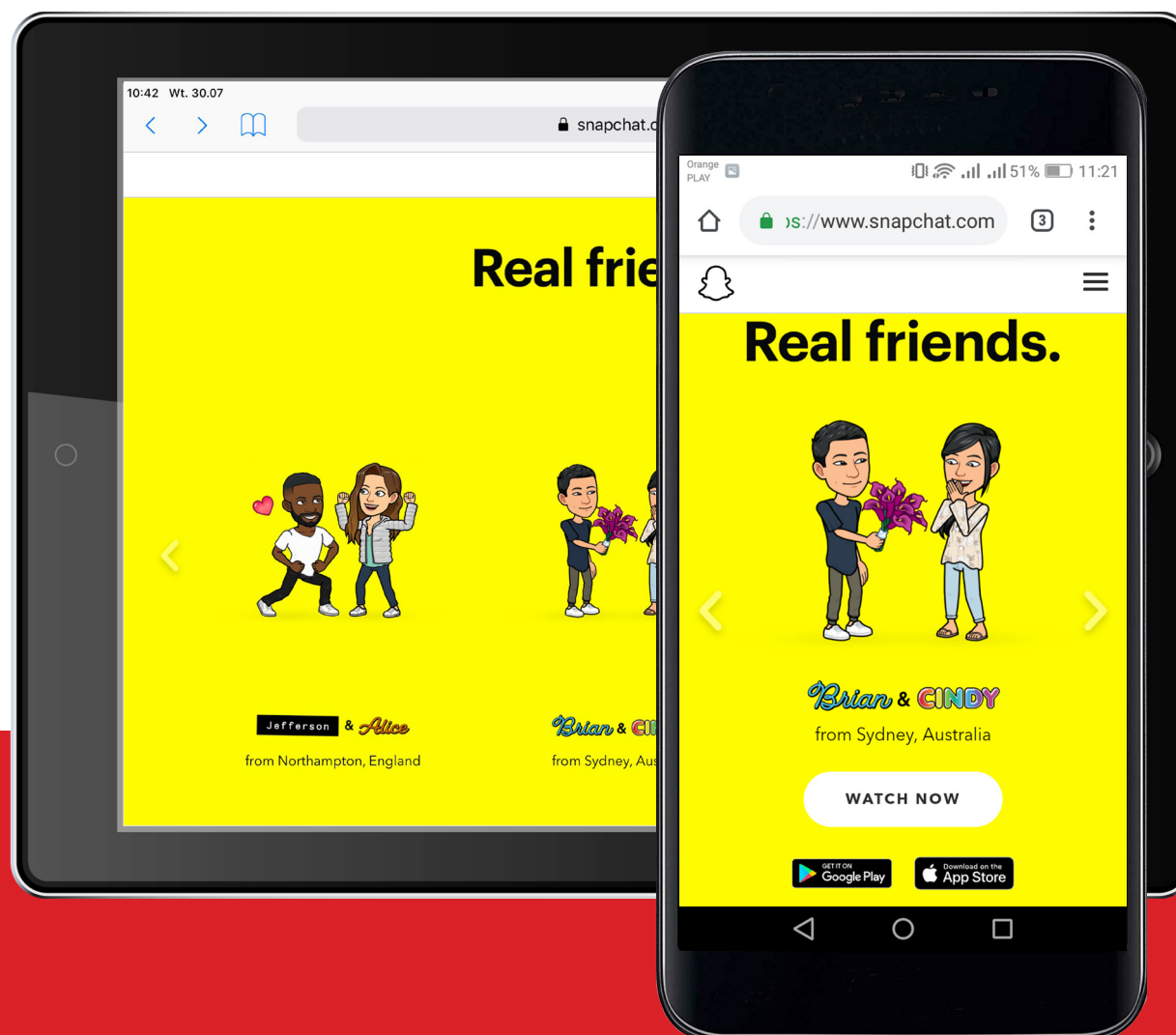
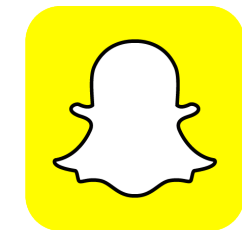

USAGE

Snapchat is a video- and photo-sharing app built only for smartphones and tablets. The main concept of the app is that a picture or video or message sent can be seen for only a short time. The time for which the content is available can be set up. This feature of Snapchat encourages a more natural interaction.

On Snapchat, which is preferred by young people, on Facebook and Twitter, you and your students can receive feedback and ideas from a large audience, including colleagues, fellow students, experts and professionals.

EASE OF ACCESS

Downloading the app and sending messages is free.

PEDAGOGICAL ASSESSMENT

Instead of struggling to stop students from using Snapchat during class, start encouraging them. Use their engagement in educational and entrepreneurial tasks. About 85% of 15- to 18-year-old students have an account on Snapchat. The app is meant to capture a moment. It enables teachers and students to send visual stories, capture the most crucial or impressive aspects of the event or the project.

Entrepreneurs could learn how to use geofilters offered by Snapchat to advertise their products.

Using Snapchat along with Twitter and Facebook to share my personal and professional life has helped me communicate to the students that I am a real person like them. I laugh, sleep, work, grade papers, teach, shop, complain (sometimes), and procrastinate (never! ;). But the point is, sharing some parts of myself in my “natural environment” helps build a rapport with students that wouldn’t otherwise exist. And this is extremely helpful for facilitating their learning and engagement in the classroom.

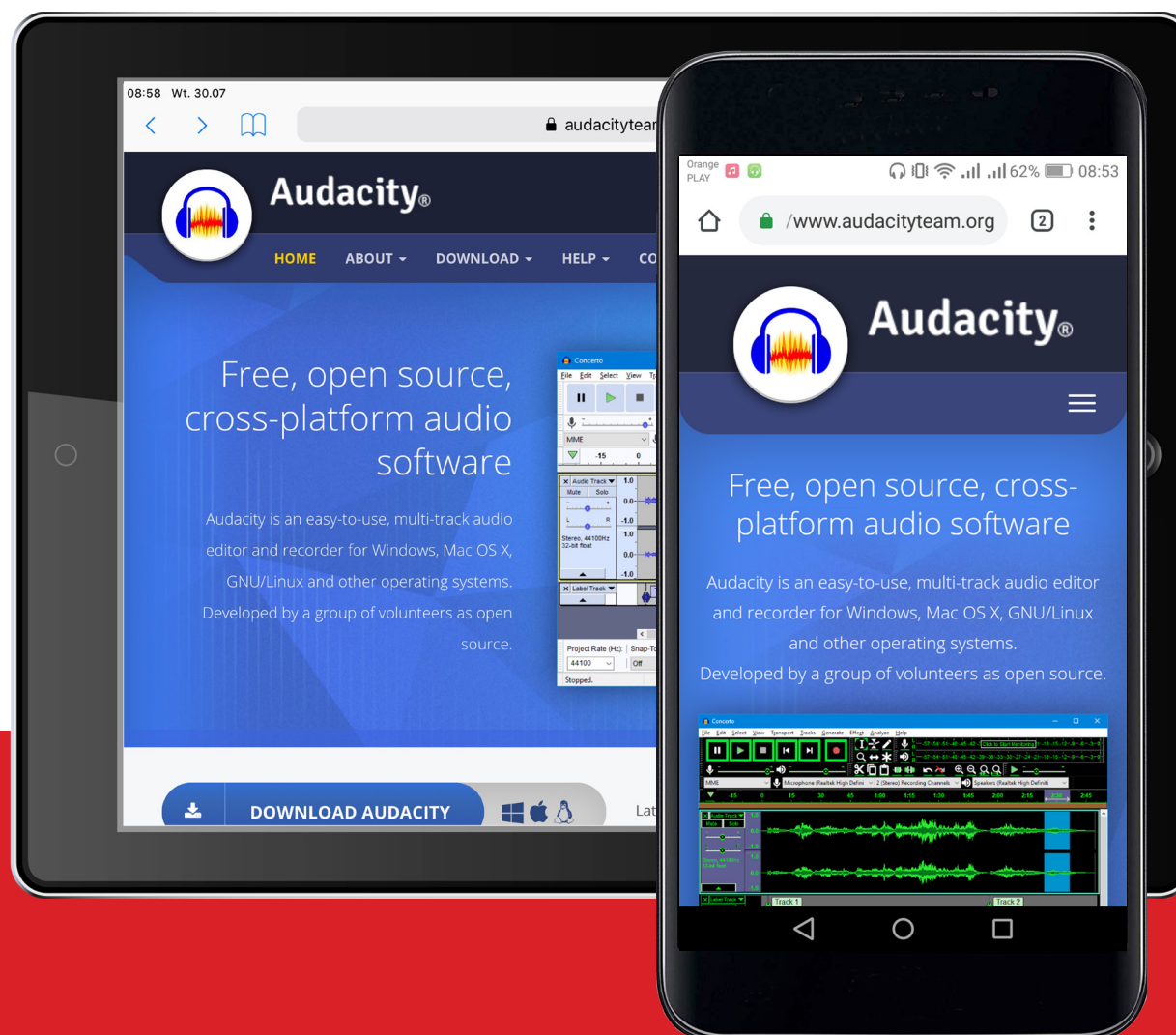

Audacity is an easy-to-use, multi-track audio editor and recorder for you to edit, cut, copy, splice or mix sounds together, record live audio, record computer playback, apply numerous effects including changing the speed or pitch of a recording. You can use Audacity in the classroom

Students and teachers can explore sound effects, and Audacity makes it easy to cut, copy, and paste music tracks, and to create new versions of songs. Students use Audacity to interview teachers, and parents, each other, incorporate these recordings into their classroom activities and upload them to streaming web servers. They learn about the best audio file formats to use. Students involved in creating sounds may become developers for Audacity, which is also a great learning opportunity for them.

EASE OF ACCESS

Audacity is well-documented and has an online manual. It runs on Linux, Windows, and Mac OS X. See the Audacity download page for downloads and instructions. Best of all, it is free and open-source software so you can use, copy, and share it freely. The program allows for future editing and revision, and export to final playback formats such as MP3 or WAV.

PEDAGOGICAL ASSESSMENT

Students can create podcasts with Audacity, record voice-overs for PowToon animated presentations. Educators can promote learning methods or save time recording comments on students' assignments. One of the projects for students could be documenting reading progress throughout the year.

I use it to record podcasts for students to provide instructions about classroom procedures and tests. Foreign language students use Audacity to record and playback their lessons. Students can download music and other types of audio tracks for sharing and re-use from Creative Commons and Wikimedia, and dub their voices onto music tracks, the sounds of birds chirping, whales and dolphins in their natural habitats, and more.
